

Notification of Enhanced Pistol Training Course

On 2-3 September, Henrico County Police Division will host Combined Firearms Training's Enhanced Pistol Training Course at Henrico County VA. This course is a two day 16 hour Law Enforcement training program approved by the National Rifle Association's Law Enforcement Activities Division and has been submitted to Virginia DCJS for 16 hours of DCJS Credit. Your agency is eligible to receive a reduced rate of \$450.00 per seat in our 2-3 September class. Attached to your email you have been provided a description and equipment requirements for the tactical carbine course. We hope that you will share this information with your officers.
