

Notification of Pistol Training Course

On 1-2 June 2021, Combined Firearms Training's Enhanced **Pistol Training Course will be hosted By Richmond Police Department.** This course is a two day 16 hour Law Enforcement training program approved by the National Rifle Association's Law Enforcement Activities Division and has been submitted **for 16 hours of VA,DCJS in service credit**. Your agency is eligible to receive a reduced rate of \$450.00 per seat in our 1-2 June class.
